Dear City of South Hutchinson resident,

As you may know, the City of South Hutchinson made a decision to contract trash and recycling collection services for city residents with Nisly Brothers. This change will be effective August 1, 2017. The city will continue to bill each resident with other utilities, then pay us.

We are a family owned and operated waste collection company based in rural Hutchinson. 2017 marks 61 years since my father, Menno Nisly, founded our company. We contract with many small cities here in central Kansas to provide trash and recycling collection. I believe our company is a great fit for your city! See the City's letter for rates.

All residents that currently have service through the city will receive a new green residential trash cart for trash and a tan recycle cart. Your new carts are scheduled to be delivered July 24-26. **If you do not want a recycle cart please call City Hall at 620-663-7104, by July 21, 2017.**

All residents who recycle are eligible for our **Nisly Rewards4Recycling** program. See the back of this letter or go to [www.nislyrewards4recycling.com](http://www.nislyrewards4recycling.com) for more information.

Our trash and recycle programs are very similar to the current programs. There will be no change to trash and recycle collection day. We will continue to pickup on Tuesday. Our first trash pickup day will be August 1, 2017. Our first recycle pickup day will be August 8, 2017. See the calendar on the back of the City's letter, and on our website for more details.

Extra boxes and bags are picked up weekly at no extra charge. If you have a bulky item like furniture, or a mattress, simply call our office to schedule the pickup at no charge. If you frequently have extra trash or recyclables and need an extra cart, call City Hall at 620-663-7104. An extra trash cart is \$5.00 and an extra recycle cart is \$3.00 extra per month.

Appliances and other metal items will be collected monthly. You may call our office to schedule a free pickup or just place the items by the curb, clearly marked by your trash cart. Metal items will be collected once each month and recycled, all at no extra charge.

A public meeting is planned at the South Hutchinson Community Building, July 20, 2017, at 7:00 PM, to explain the transition and answer any questions.

**We recycle**

City Trash Customers:

At the May 1, 2017 meeting, the City Council received proposals for residential trash service. The five year contract with Stutzman's Refuse Disposal was set to expire on August 1, 2017 and the Council felt it was appropriate to open the bidding to all haulers that met the City's qualifications. The Council reviewed two proposals, one from Stutzman's Refuse Disposal and Nisly Brothers. Both proposals are available on the City's website, [www.southhutch.com](http://www.southhutch.com) or by coming into City Hall. After much deliberation, the Council voted 4-0 to approve a five year agreement with Nisly Brothers starting August 1, 2017.

The enclosed information from Nisly explains the transition process. There should be no interruption in service. Billing will still be done through your city utility bill. Rates will also decrease slightly to \$11.05 per month. Additional trash carts will be \$5.00 per month and extra recycling carts will be \$3.00 per month. Trash will still be picked on Tuesdays with recycling every other week using the current schedule. Old carts will be picked up after trash day the week of July 24-28 and new carts will be delivered the same week to ensure continuation in service.

Trash service for residents has been franchised since 2004. Those opting to receive trash and recycling service at their home must use the city contracted provider. Residents can also choose to haul their trash to the Reno County Landfill. Franchised trash service saves residents money and reduces the wear and tear on city roads by limiting the number of trucks and days of service.

A meeting to answer any questions about the transition will be held on July 20<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM in the Community Center, 101 W Avenue C.
